

Get The Immigration Assistance That You Need



Older new Americans and refugees have specialized needs. We can help you navigate aging in America with these services and more!

Assistance with applications for US citizenship or naturalization

To keep your Social Security benefits in place, you generally have to become a citizen or naturalize within 7 years of arriving to the US.

Adjustment of Status

We will assist with adjustment of status to Lawful Permanent Resident (“LPR” or green card) for individuals currently holding refugee, asylee and other lawful visa statuses.

Assistance with applications for Appropriate Travel Documents

Services available for refugees, asylees and LPRs who need to travel outside of the US prior to obtaining citizenship.

Application for Derivative Legal Entry to the US

We will assist family members of current refugees, asylees and LPRs.
